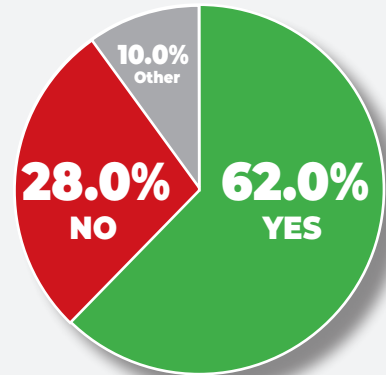
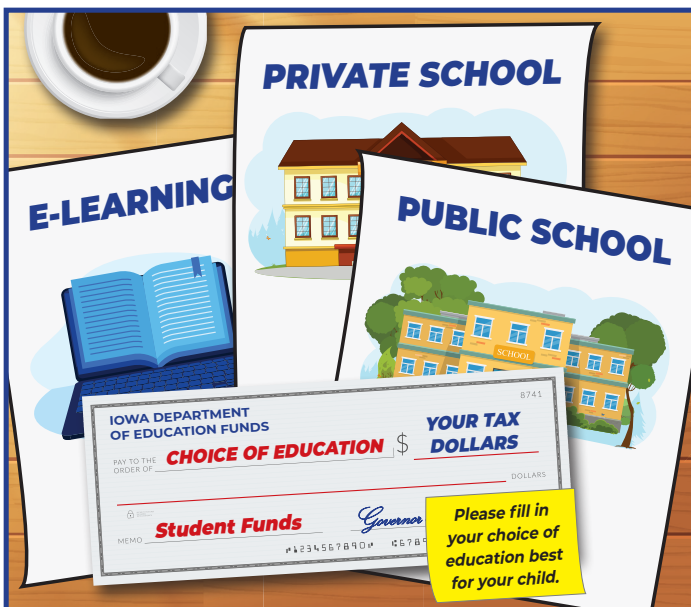


EDUCATION DOLLARS FOLLOWING STUDENTS

Public education is not only the largest state budget driver, but local school districts are often responsible for the largest portion of a property tax bill.



Education Savings Accounts:
