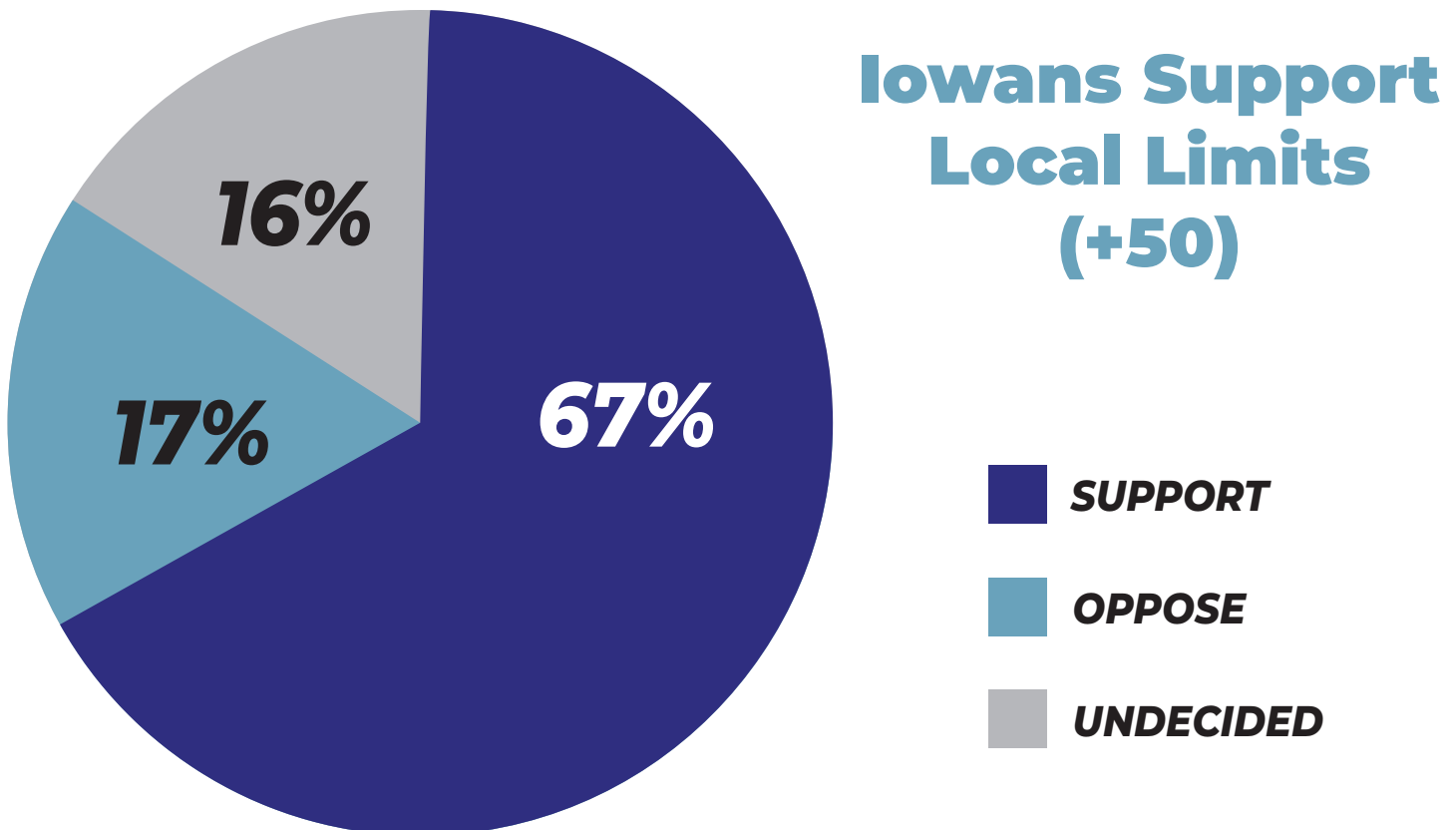


Iowans Support Limiting Local Government Spending

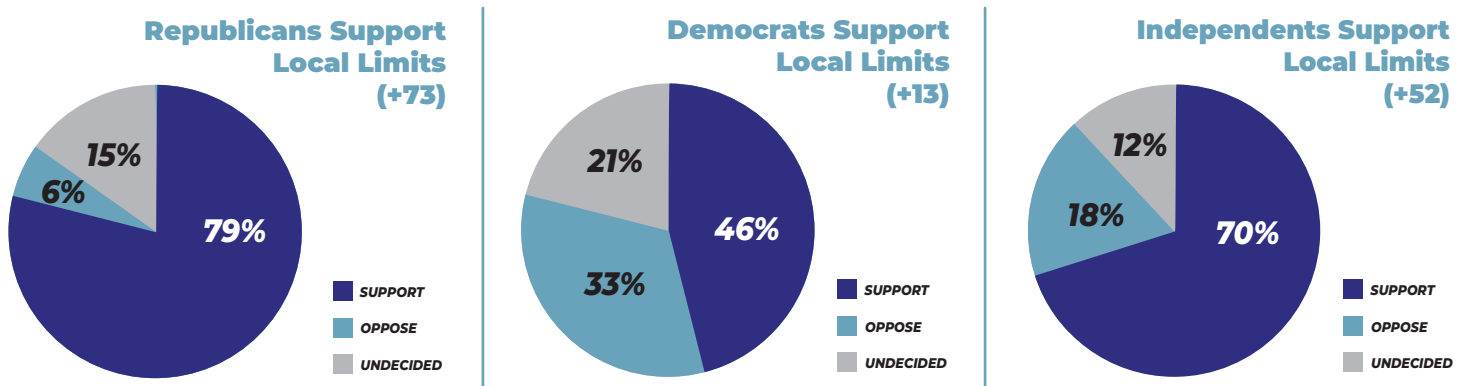


The most recent ITR Foundation Poll measured public opinion on local government spending limits by asking:

To control the growth of property taxes, do you support or oppose the state general assembly setting limits on how much a local government can tax and spend?



These topline results show the issue has a net favorability among Iowa voters of over 49%, with 66.6% of poll respondents supporting new limits, and only 17.3% of respondents opposing them. This issue seems to transcend party lines, as well, with a breakout of Republican, Democrat, and Independent support provided below.
